### **Announcement to all MD18 Lions and LEOs:**

We are encouraging all LEOs to consider becoming leaders beyond your own club and community by running for an office in our state organization, MD18 LEOs. The Council was formed; a Constitution and Bylaws was adopted, and officer elections were held at the LEO Gathering last year. We hope to achieve diversity among our various clubs statewide, so please plan to participate in the elections this month.

### **MD18 LEO Officer Election LEO Gathering and Conference March 25-27, 2011**

According to Lions International's Standard LEO Multiple District Constitution as adopted and amended at the LEO Conference in 2010, the election of statewide officers to the LEO Multiple District Council will be conducted with the following criteria. This is a synopsis of the adopted Constitution:

1. Officers to be elected are: president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, chaplain, membership chairperson, and public awareness officer.
2. A member in good standing shall be nominated by any recognized LEO club in good standing in MD18. Nominations may be made from the floor followed with a second.
3. A candidate can have a dual nomination for president and vice president.
4. Candidates should have the endorsement of his/her LEO Club and sponsoring Lions Club.
5. Presidential candidates must have served as president of a LEO club.
6. Voting delegates will be determined with one voting delegate for each ten members of the club in good standing.
7. A club in good standing will have paid all fees and levies to Lions International and MD18 LEOs.
